The Humane Society of the United States promotes an agenda that is damaging to pet breeders. It is among the wealthiest animal rights legislative forces in the U.S. but less than 10% of their \$100 million per year income (non-taxable donations) helps animals



in any way. In the last ten years, it has expended over \$500 million on lobbying in support of approximately 1000 laws, although it was established as a public charity.

In an article titled Know Thy Enemy, <u>The Dog Press</u> website states: "HSUS spends millions on programs that seek to economically cripple meat and dairy producers; eliminate the use of animals in biomedical research labs; phase out pet breeding, zoos, and circus animal acts; and demonize hunters as crazed lunatics." HSUS is also behind the currently popular legislation to prevent the sale of your puppies at pet shops.
